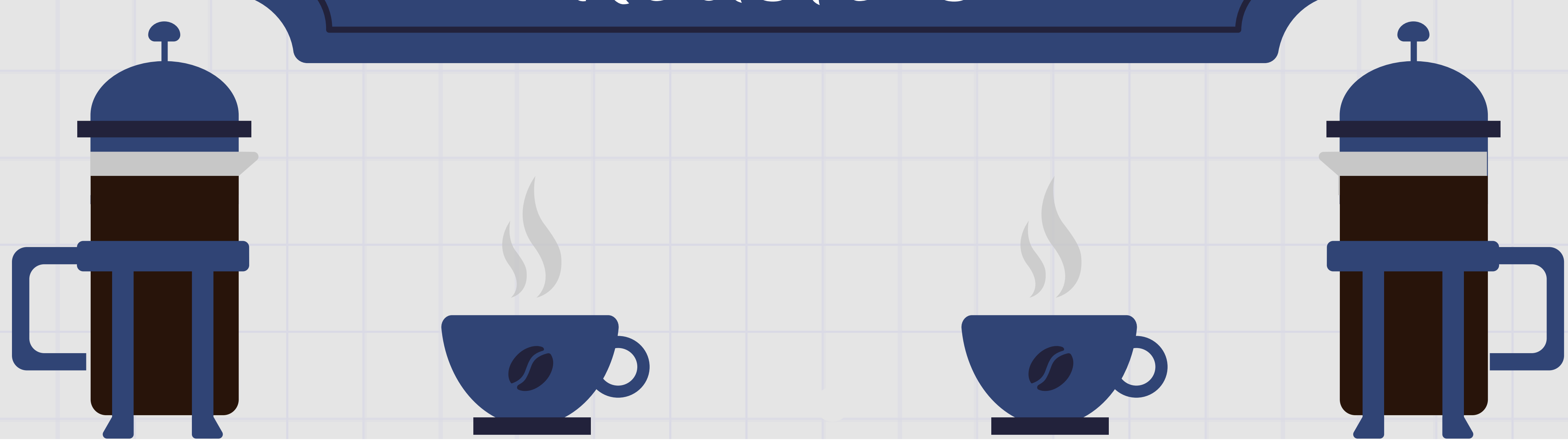


Nordhavn Coffee Roasters

The Process

STEP 01

The coffee beans are imported from various countries around the world like Peru, Indonesia, and Tanzania. NCR works with trusted suppliers for sustainability and quality.

STEP 02

Roasting

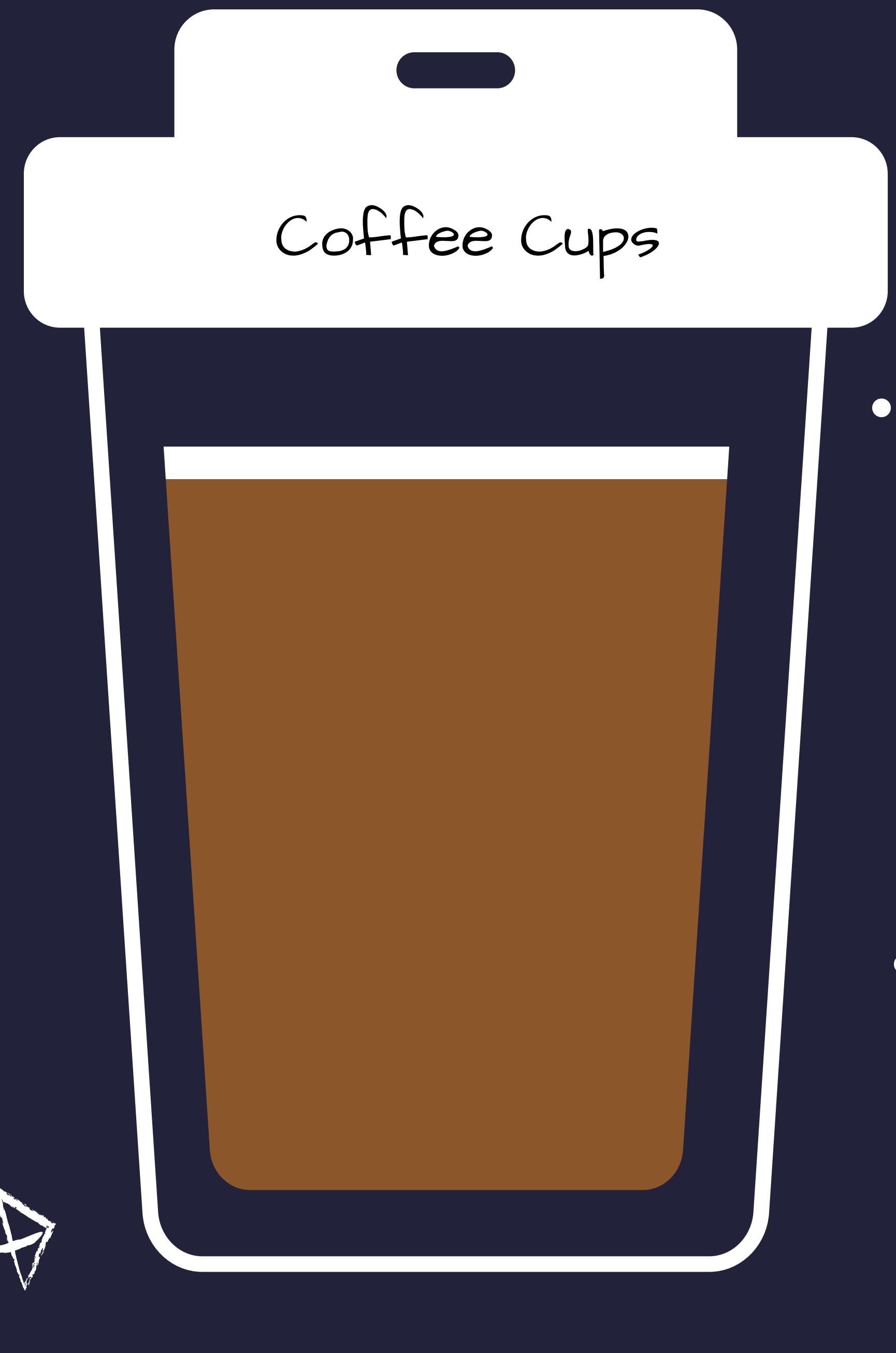
- The roasting process takes 10-15 minutes then they are cooled down as to not overheat
- Products either single origin or a blend
- After roasting and cooling the beans are cleaned and sorted to remove unwanted material that may have travelled with the beans (i.e. pieces of dirt/concrete/rubble or other plant material)

STEP 03

After roasting the coffee is put into separate tubs to cool then sent to the customer

STEP 04

The roasted beans are then packaged and delivered to various sellers across Denmark
